Job Description:

A CMM operator has the precision task of operating a co-ordinate measuring machine. CMM is the industry standard term for the three-dimensional measuring machines used by manufacturers to ensure that a product conforms to certain legally mandated consumer standards. The operator ensures that the product does not fall short of the quality standards required by the consumer.

Reporting to: CMM Department Manager

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

Responsible for the execution of tasks as listed below to ensure our products meet or exceed quality standards.

- Complete routine machine maintenance daily fill out maintenance sheets (wipe ways, etc.)
- Review CMM lineup for next job or night shift summary to determine what is needed to finish existing job
- When setting up new job on table, ensure the feet are clean and stoned flat (does not rock)
 - If job rocks on feet, machine or grind accordingly before clamping on CMM table (careful not to distort base)
 - Work with Fixture Builders and Fixture Leaders to develop a plan to measure and adjust fixtures as required
- Run CMM programs to inspect fixtures to nominal part data inserting more points and tip angles
- Position details on fixture assemblies to nominal position using customer specific tolerances
 - o If out of tolerance determine best case path to complete corrections with Build Leader
- Using CMM data, develop reports to meet the customer requirements
- Store CMM data, reports and documents according to defined structure and naming convention
- Perform gauge R&R's as well as part layouts
- Troubleshoot existing CMM programs and reports
- Assist in problem solving and continuous improvement activities
- Assist as needed in the calibration and certification of all process inspection & test equipment
- Learn and operate existing Roamer Arm
- Ensure timely completion of layouts and reports
- Perform ball bar test between new projects. Record values and inform Fixture Manager if machine is out of calibration
- Report any crashes to Fixture manager
- Mentor/train juniors and/or apprentices



- Apply Lean principles
- Other duties as required by Select Tool Management
